RE: State Mandated School Closures; CTE Academy Closure Information

Governor JB Pritzker's Executive Order 2020-05 closes all Illinois school districts from March 17, 2020 thru Monday, March 30, 2020. School districts are scheduled to reopen on Tuesday, March 31, 2020. Executive Order 2020-05 is linked below.

Our CTE Academy Staff will be maintaining a **continuity of education** with students thru e-mail, electronic platforms, and "paper" assignments. The "paper" assignments (for students withOUT technology or Internet access) will be in the CTE Academy office between 6:00 AM and 2:00 PM daily.

As determined by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) and the Governor's Executive Order, all school days from March 17, 2020 to March 30, 2020 are considered Act of God days and therefore are non-instructional days. Act of God days will not be re-scheduled.

ISBE has also dictated NO work during this time is intended to be graded or used as an assessment for students. They emphasized that this was to make sure that all students in Illinois are treated equitably.

The sanitization of the CTE Academy will begin on Monday, March 16, 2020 after the dismissal of PM students. The sanitization will continue thru the week.
